<u>Lego</u> – Do you enjoy creating something original and one of a kind? Do you like to be part of a team inventing something amazing or would you rather create your own masterpiece? If you said yes to these questions than the LEGO SPARK may be for you.

2. <u>Bouldering</u> - Want to learn how to rock climb? Come climb at the Fredericton Bouldering Coop! This rock-climbing SPARK offers 30 minutes of instruction on climbing techniques and safety, followed by 30 minutes of climbing practice on their indoor bouldering walls. Students will be bused to the facility and back to the school for 3 weeks. For one week, students will participate in climbing related activities in or around the school.
